



Gifts to ICW help students and the state

Thanks to generous support from corporations, foundations, and individuals, more than \$1 million in student aid was distributed to ICW member schools last year. Included in the distribution is nearly \$250,000 in named scholarships, serving 150 students.

Philanthropic gifts to ICW not only serve students well, they also help Washington state by broadening educational opportunities for residents and enabling students to use the capacity in the independent college sector. Washington independent colleges and universities save the state, conservatively, \$280 million a year in student subsidies (not including capital costs).

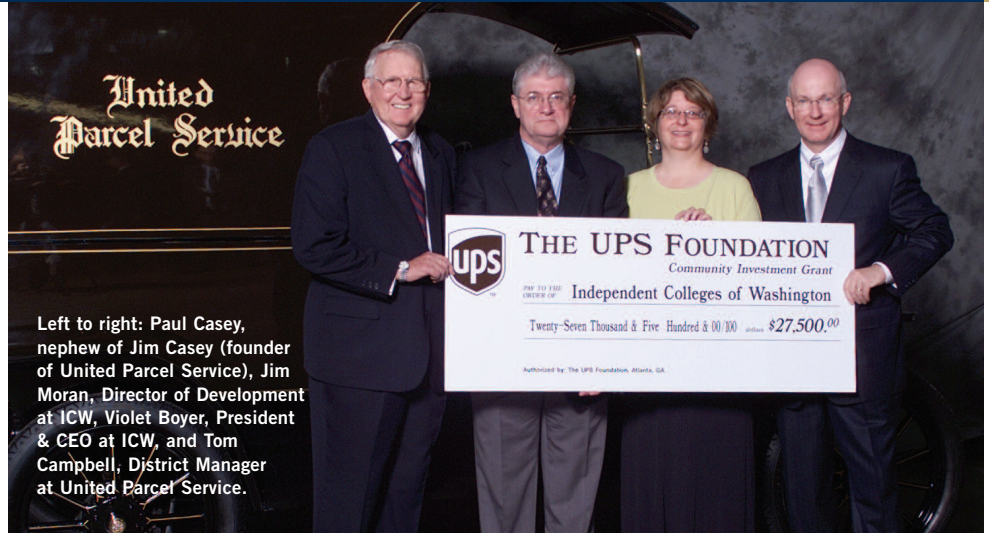
COLLEGE UPDATES
