I hope to always be a valued member of whatever community I find myself in... and teach or mentor. I hope to be an agent of change and influence, and always keep learning and expanding my horizons.

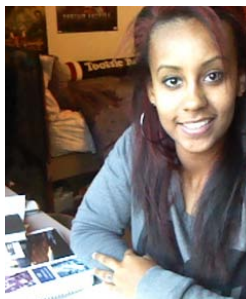
