Demonstrated financial need required.	Obtain ICW general application from your college financial aid office or at the ICW web site . Must be submitted to ICW by March 13, 2010 .
William G. Saletic Scholarship (1)	Confirmed	Non-renewable scholarship of up to \$1,000.	Applicant must be a junior or senior at the time of the award, majoring in or studying politics or history.	Obtain ICW general application from your college financial aid office or at the ICW web site . Must be submitted to ICW by March 13, 2010 .
 The Boeing Company Scholarship (1)	Confirmed	Non-renewable award of up to \$2,500.	Applicant must be enrolled at an ICW institution at the time of the award. Applicants should demonstrate involvement in community service and have a minimum 3.25 GPA.	Obtain ICW general application from your college financial aid office or at the ICW web site . Must be submitted to ICW by March 13, 2010 .
Garrett J. Goodchild Achievement Award (1)	Confirmed	\$20,000 awarded \$5,000/year for up to 4 years to a graduating senior from either Eastlake or Redmond High School.	Criteria include academic merit, demonstrated financial need, and school and community contributions. Subsequent grants conditional on honoree maintaining a 3.0 GPA each year the scholarship is provided.	Obtain ICW Goodchild application from the EHS or RHS Counseling office or at the ICW web site . Must be submitted to ICW by March 13, 2010 .

E. K. & Lillian F. Bishop Foundation Scholarship	Confirmed	Non-renewable award of up to \$1000.	Applicant must have a permanent home address in Grays Harbor County, WA., Applicant should articulate the impact Grays Harbor County has had on them in the essay.	Obtain ICW general application from your college financial aid office or at the ICW web site . Must be submitted to ICW by March 13, 2010 .
Stanley O. McNaughton Community Service Award (2)	Confirmed	Non-renewable award of \$2,500 to a junior or senior.	Applicant must be a junior or senior at time of the award. Applicant should demonstrate commitment to community service both in high school and college.	Obtain ICW general application from your college financial aid office or at the ICW web site . Must be submitted to ICW by March 13, 2010 .

ICW/Boyer Scholarship (10)	Confirmed	Non-renewable award of \$1,000 each.	Recipients should be contributing to the campus community.	No application required. Each ICW college or university makes selection from all eligible students.
William W. Kilworth Scholarships (10)	Pending	Non-renewable award of \$500 each.	Recipients must be from Pierce County.	No application required. Each ICW college or university makes selection from all eligible students.
Norcliffe Foundation Scholarships (10)	Confirmed	Non-renewable award of \$1,500 to a student with a permanent resident address in the Puget Sound area.	Recipients must be from the Puget Sound area.	No application required. Each ICW college or university makes selection from all eligible students.

Recipients must be a senior at Gonzaga University or Whitworth University and majoring in business. Recipient must also maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better and live within 70 miles of Spokane.	No application required. Gonzaga University and Whitworth University financial aid offices make selections from all eligible students.

Merit performance, as evaluated by individual college or university.	No application required. Each ICW college or university makes selection from all eligible students.
