Must be submitted to ICW by <b>March 31, 2012</b> .

Bishop Foundation Scholarship</b> (1)	Confirmed	Non-renewable award of \$1,000 to students with a permanent resident address in the Grays Harbor County, WA attending an ICW member institution	Applicant must have a permanent home address in Grays Harbor County, WA, and should articulate the impact Grays Harbor County has had on them in the essay. Demonstrated financial need required.	Obtain ICW general application from your college financial aid office or at the <a href="#">ICW web site</a> .  Must be submitted to ICW by <b>March 31, 2012</b> .
 <b>The Boeing Company Scholarship</b> (1)	Confirmed	Non-renewable award of \$2,500 attending an ICW member institution	Applicant must be a junior or senior at time of the award (Fall 2012), and majoring in science, technology, engineering or mathematics field. Applicants should demonstrate involvement in community service, and have a minimum 3.25 GPA.	Obtain ICW general application from your college financial aid office or at the <a href="#">ICW web site</a> .  Must be submitted to ICW by <b>March 31, 2012</b> .
<b>Garrett J. Goodchild Achievement Award</b> (1)	Confirmed	\$20,000 awarded \$5,000/year for up to 4 years to a graduating senior from either Eastlake or Redmond High School attending an ICW member institution	Criterion includes academic merit, school and community contributions, demonstrated financial need is considered. Subsequent grants conditional on honoree maintaining a 3.0 GPA each year the scholarship is provided.	Once scholarship is confirmed, obtain ICW <b>Goodchild</b> application from the EHS or RHS Counseling office or at the <a href="#">ICW web site</a> .  Must be submitted to ICW by <b>March 31, 2012</b> .

Selection is based on ability to benefit from an independent college. Students with cumulative GPAs of 2.5 to 3.0 are encouraged to apply.	Obtain ICW general application from your college financial aid office or at the <a href="#">ICW web site</a> . Must be submitted to ICW by <b>March 31, 2012</b> .
<b>Stanley O. McNaughton Community Service Award (2)</b>	Confirmed	Non-renewable award of \$2,500 to a junior or senior attending an ICW member institution	Applicant must be a junior or senior at time of the award (Fall 2012). Applicant should demonstrate commitment to community service, both in high school and college. Demonstrated financial need required.	Obtain ICW general application from your college financial aid office or at the <a href="#">ICW web site</a> . Must be submitted to ICW by <b>March 31, 2012</b> .
<b>William G. Saletic Scholarship (1)</b>	Unconfirmed	Non-renewable award to a junior or senior of up to \$1,000 attending an ICW member institution	Applicant must be a junior or senior at the time of the award (Fall 2012), majoring in or studying politics or history. GPAs of 2.5 or above are encouraged to apply.	Obtain ICW general application from your college financial aid office or at the <a href="#">ICW web site</a> . Must be submitted to ICW by <b>March 31, 2012</b> .
