Step 1: The next page is a spreadsheet showing the 6 ICW scholarships available to current college students. Review the requirements carefully to make sure you qualify.

Step 2: Create a one-page **resume** that highlights community and campus activities, honors and/or awards, employment history, and leadership positions. Save this document as a PDF.

Step 3: Obtain a PDF or JPG copy of your **college transcript(s)** that clearly displays your full name, course grades, and cumulative GPA. An unofficial copy or screenshot is acceptable.

Step 4: Complete a **3000 character essay** (approx. 1 page). Essay instructions for each scholarship can be found on page 2 of this form.

After you have completed steps 2, 3, and 4, you are ready to submit all three documents online.

Step 5: Go to <http://www.icwashington.org/scholarships/> and click on "Scholarships for Current College Students Requiring an Application" for all competitive scholarships. Be prepared to complete the application in one sitting – you cannot stop and restart.

Step 6: To apply for another scholarship, return to steps 2, 3, 4, and 5.

IMPORTANT – Some scholarships require ICW to verify your level of financial need. Your financial aid office will only provide information to ICW if you check "yes" to authorize the release of this information. If you check "no" on the application, your application will not be considered.
